

Hanover Repair Pilot Program

We just launched a pilot program serving low income senior citizens in the 23111 or 23116 zip code in the Hanover suburban service area, or 'old Mechanicsville.' Due to COVID, we are only able to address exterior repairs at this time.

Critical Repairs

All extensive work performed will address health and safety issues or code violations, such as:

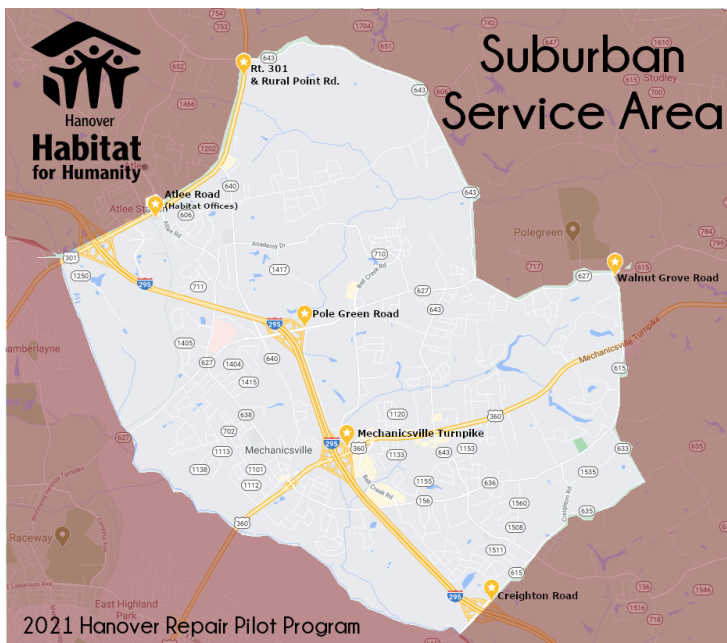
- Repair/replace roof
- Address crucial electrical, plumbing, or HVAC needs
- Replace damaged fascia, caulk and paint as needed
- Install/replace gutters and downspouts, as needed
- Porch, steps and deck repair

Who qualifies?

- Applicant must have lived in Hanover county for at least one year.
- Property must be owner-occupied.
- Applicant must be up-to-date on mortgage payments and taxes.
- Household income must be 50% or less than Area Median Income in Hanover County, with a maximum income of \$44,700. (If you have more than 4 people in your household, contact the office for adjusted income limits.)

Our pilot program offers repairs to local, homeowners to make their houses accessible, livable, and energy efficient. We provide senior adults with repairs to maintain their independence and age in place.
